

**PUBLIC HEARING OF THE ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**


November 2, 2015


A Public Hearing was held by the Annville Township Board of Commissioners starting at 7:25 PM on November 2, 2015 in the Commissioners' Room of Annville Town Hall, 36 North Lancaster Street, Annville, PA to hear public comment on the proposed 2016 budget.

The following members were present: Rex A. Moore, President; James W. Scott, Vice President; Thomas R. Embich, Treasurer; and Henri B. Lively. Also in attendance were Nicholas T. Yingst, Township Administrator and Board Secretary; Bernard Dugan, Chief of Police; Timothy D. Sheffey, Township Solicitor; Paul Longenecker, Chief of the Union Hose Fire Company; Marylouise Sholly, *The Lebanon Daily News*; Millie Kish, Maple Street; Ronald Moyer, North Railroad Street; and Dean Wolfe, West Main Street.

President Moore called the Public Hearing to order, at which point Administrator Yingst reported that the hearing was properly advertised and the proposed 2016 budget has been available for review in the Township Office and on the Township website since October 14, 2015. President Moore then asked for any comments from those in attendance. Millie Kish of Maple Street thanked the Board for their hard work preparing the budget and complimented them on what she believed to be a sound financial plan for 2016. She also noted her support for the \$2,500 budgeted increase in the donation to the Annville Free Library. Paul Longenecker, Chief of the Union Hose Fire Company, thanked the Board for the \$2,000 budgeted increase in the donation to fire department and briefly discussed with Administrator Yingst the change in the budgeted amount to the Firemen's Relief Association payment received from the State.

Hearing no further questions or comments, President Moore asked for a motion to close the Public Hearing. **MOTION** by Mr. Scott, second by President Moore to close the Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously and the hearing was declared closed at 7:27 PM.
